### **RULES**

- 1. Judging will be done on an overall basis, including costumes, hairstyle and accessories.
- 2. Teams may choreograph their walk and select a background music.
- 3. Stunts which pose any risk to life are not permitted.

- 4. Using any substance (or prop) that poses danger or might alter the stage in any way for the next team is not allowed (e.g. spilling of liquid that will affect the dryness).
- 5. The teams will be expected to restore the stage to its original condition within the set time limit in case any prop or substance that causes temporary changes is used.
- 6. Each team will get maximum 10 minimum and (5 minimum buffer time)
- 7. Obscenity will left to judges' discretion, and their decision will be final and binding in case any part of the performance is found objectionable.

- 2. The play could be in English, Hindi.
- 3. One team should contain minimum 6 members
- 4. Teams are allowed to have one member for the backstage work.
- 5. Any Inappropriate content or vulgarity will not be tolerated.
- 6. Spillage of any item is strictly not allowed onstage.
- 7. The decision of the judges shall be final and abiding.



# Monologne

### **ABOUT**

In civilized life, where the happiness, and indeed almost the existence, of man, depends so much upon the opinion of his fellow men, he is always acting a studied part. In a Mono Act, an actor is vulnerable. His total personality is exposed to critical judgment - his intellect, his bearing, his diction, his whole appearance. If you can reveal your emotions in front of the audience, here is your chance.

- I. In Mono act only single person allowed to be on stage.
- 2. A participant can have a maximum of I helper for the backstage.
- 3. The act can be in English or Hindi.
- 4. Time Limit: 4-10 minutes.
- 5. Spillage of any item is strictly not allowed onstage.
- 6. Points will be deducted on exceeding the time limit.
- 7. Any Inappropriate content or vulgarity will not be tolerated.
- 8. The decision of the judges and organizers shall be final and abiding.



# Nukand Natak

### **ABOUT**

In this fast-developing world, very few people have a natural taste for drama. If you can catch the attention & attract people to stay and watch your performance, here is your chance. The art of grabbing the audience's attention is all that you need. No lights, no mics, only pure ACTION full of energy.

- 1. Team size: 10-30 members, including 2 for management.
- 2. Time limit: 15-30 minutes; points deducted for exceeding.
- 3. Judging criteria: Acting, Voice (Sync, modulation, diction), Screenplay, Script, Audience Interaction, Overall Impact.
- 4. Language restriction: Only English or Hindi allowed.
- 5. Prohibited items: No electrical appliances, live animals, flames, or heavy objects.
- 6. Use of dry colours permitted, with mandatory stage cleaning postperformance.
- 7. Disqualification for plagiarism or profanity; judges' decision is final.











4. The decisions of the judges will be final and abiding.



# Live Sketching

### **ABOUT**

Individual event where participants need to sketch a scene in front of them. The scene will be a wide area to accommodate all the participants from different Institutes simultaneously and to add variations to their submissions.

- 1. Medium: Graphite pencils provided.
- 2. Drawing Sheet: Off-White A<sub>3</sub> size.
- 3. Bring all relevant materials.
- 4. Scale not allowed in live sketching.
- 5. Thick cardboard provided as a drawing base.
- 6. No external help (internet/photographs) allowed during the event.
- 7. Judging Criteria: Proportion & Perspective, Composition and Components, Shading.
- 8. Duration: 4 hours.
- 9. Judges' decision final and binding.

- 1. Team size: Maximum of two members.
- 2. Time limit: 2 hours.

- 4. Judging Criteria: Proportion & Perspective, Composition, Creativity.
- 5. Judges' decision final and binding.






# Kangoli

### **ABOUT**

Immerse yourself in the vibrant tradition of colors and celebrate the artistry of crafting intricate designs using the vibrant hues of powdered colors. Join us to showcase your creativity, precision, and cultural flair as you craft stunning rangolis on the canvas of the floor.

- 1. Team Limit: Maximum of 3 members per team.
- 2. Time Limit: 180 minutes for completion.
- 3. Event Nature: Team-based; on-spot registrations permitted.
- 4. Rangoli Theme: Provided on the spot for all participating teams.
- 5. Rangoli Size: Each creation should measure 3ft X 3ft.
- 6. No Personal Indications: Prohibited; no marks or writing allowed on the Rangoli.
- 7. Colours: Teams must bring their own Rangoli colors.









# Solo Singing

There will be 7 solo singing performance and there will be 3 prizes for performers.

- 1. Time Limit: 21 Minutes
- 2. Performance Options: Only Guitar or Karaoke play allowed.
- 3. Materials: Bring your own materials.
- 4. Judging Criteria: Voice quality, pitch balance, pronunciation.
- 5. Judging Decision: Judges' decisions are final and binding.
- 6. Performance Duration: Each performer has a maximum of 3 minutes.
- 7. No External Help: No internet or photographs allowed during the event.



# Onet Singing

### **ABOUT**

Duet Singing will be available for few students.
Only 5 team will perform and one prize for winner team.

- I. Time Limit: 20 minutes
- 2. Each team will have a maximum of 4 minutes.
- 3. Only Guitar or Karaoke allowed for performance.
- 4. Bring your own materials.
- 5. No external help (e.g. internet/photographs) allowed during the event.
- 6. Judging Criteria: Voice quality, pitch balance, pronunciation.
- 7. Judges' decision will be final and binding.
- 8. Each team can only have 2 members.

Group will perform on stage where each group can contain maximum 5 members. First winner group will get one Prize.


### **RULES**

- 1. Individual event: JAM session.
- 2. Multiple rounds in finals.
- 3. Judging based on spontaneity, wit, humor, grammar, and other criteria.
- 4. No vulgarity permitted.
- 5. Judges' decision final.
- 6. Multiple participants allowed from one institution.
- 7. Rules subject to JAM Master's discretion.
- 8. Jammers must be clear and fluent.
- 9. Each elimination round: 6-8 participants.
- 10. 6-8 finalists chosen for extended round.



# Pickup Panga

### **ABOUT**

A Pick-up Line game is typically a lighthearted and entertaining game where participants showcase their creativity and humor by delivering amusing pick-up lines.

- 1. Ensure pickup lines are light-hearted, humorous, and respectful.
- 2. Avoid anything offensive and inappropriate.





# Jo Hara Wahi Sikander

### **ABOUT**

The phrase "Jo Hara Wahi Sikander" is a Hindi saying that translates to "The one who loses is conqueror." It is often used in the context of sports or games, conveying the notion that facing challenges and learning from defeat can lead to eventual triumph.

- 1. Each participant takes turns speaking on a given topic.
- 2. The goal is to be perceived as the least enjoyable speaker by the judges or audience.
- 3. Judges may consider factors like coherence, relevance, and delivery in determining the worst speaker.
- 4. Participants cannot use offensive language or violate any ethical standards.
- 5. Time limits may be imposed for each speaker to ensure a fair and structured competition.
- 6. Judges' decisions are final, and their criteria may vary based on the nature of the event.
- 7. Good sportsmanship is encouraged, and participants should maintain a light-hearted and humorous atmosphere.





# Andio Bhoolphuliya

Audio bhool bhulaiya is the ultimate game experience where music meets acting. Grab your headphone and get ready to immerse yourself in a world of tunes and creativity. In this game your team selects the perfect song for you to listen to while your friend acts out a character or scenario based on a given name. With just one minute on the clock, it's up to you to guess who or what they're portraying. It's a test of communication, quick thinking, and musical intuition. Get ready to laugh, dance, and guess your way to victory in audio bhool bhulaiya.

- 1. The volume of the music will be high in the headphones during play.
- 2. Candidates who are whispering cannot perform actions for the hints.
- 3. The person who whispers should maintain decency with words while whispering.
- 4. The sentence whispered cannot be changed by the person whispering.

# Ready to Dance

(SOLO DANCE COMPETITION)

### **ABOUT & RULES**

### Round 1 - Prelims:

- 1. Format: Offline prelims will be conducted with any dance style allowed.
- 2. Time Limit: 1 to 1:30 minutes per performance.
- 3. Props: Not allowed.
- 4. Music: Mixing of tracks is allowed.
- 5. Content: No vulgar or obscene content allowed.

### Round 2 - Finals:

- I. Time Limit: Performances should be between 2 to 4 minutes.
- 2. Props: Participants must use a property of their choice, but it should not vandalize the stage.
- 3. Stage Condition: Participants must restore the stage to its original condition within the set time limit.
- 4. Prohibited Items: Inflammable objects, powder, water, and heavy objects are not allowed on stage.
- 5. Punctuality: Marks will be reduced if the time limit is not followed.
- 6. Content: No obscenity allowed.
- 7. The decision of judge is final and binding.

These guidelines ensure a fair and entertaining competition while also prioritizing safety and respect for the stage.



# Onre 2 Onet (DUET DANCE COMPETITION)

### **ABOUT & RULES**

### Round 1:- Prelims

- 1.1 to 1:30 minutes performance
- 2. All styles are allowed.
- 3. Properties are allowed as long as they don't vandalize the stage.
- 4. The top 15 out of the lot would be selected for the second round.
- 5. Negative marks will be awarded for the participants who exceed the time limit.

### Round 2:- Finals

- 1.2-3 mins performance
- 2. All styles are allowed.
- 3. Properties are allowed as long as they don't vandalize the stage.
- 4. Negative marks will be awarded for the participants who exceed the time limit
- 5. The decision of the judge is final and binding.









### **ABOUT & RULES**

### Max of participants 5-15 Members

### Round 1:- Prelims

- 1. Offline prelims will be conducted. any dance style is allowed
- 2. Time limit is 1 to 2 mins
- 3. Innovative theme will be given due weightage for selection to the final round.
- 4. Usage of props is allowed
- 5. Mixing of tracks is allowed
- 6. No vulgarity or obscenity will be entertained.
- 7. All members of the team must be present on the stage for at least 10 seconds.

### Round 2:- Finals

Final round of the competition any dance style is allowed.

- 1. Time limit is 5 mins
- 2.Usage of props is allowed as long as they don't harm the stage: any loss/damage of the props will not be the responsibility of the coordinators
- 3. Any kind of dangerous objects like flames, powders or fluids are strictly prohibited.
- 4. Mixing of tracks is allowed
- 5. No vulgarity or obscenity will be entertained.
- 6. Any kind of indisciplinary action from the participants during the course of performance or other times will lead to disqualification.
- 7. Failure to follow the above rules will result in heavy penalties per minute.
- 8. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
- 9. Innovative acts as per the decision of judges will be awarded separately.





### **ABOUT & RULES**

- 1. All dance styles are allowed.
- 2. The songs may not pertain to any particular style or form.
- 3. At the start of each round, 10 seconds buffer time would be given, after which the 30 seconds time limit to perform would start.
- 4. Points would be deducted if the participant does not adhere to the rules of each round.
- 5. You cannot physically harm or touch the opponent in an inappropriate manner during the battle and failure in adhering to this will lead to a significant point loss or disqualification.
- 6. Any display of vulgarity or indecency will not be tolerated.

### Round 1:-

- 1. All registered participants will compete in an individual cypher.
- 2. Each participant will receive 30 seconds to perform their freestyle.
- 3.A 10-second buffer will be provided before the 30-second time limit in order to understand the music track being played.
- 4. The song will switch after every pair of contestants.
- 5. The top 16 (based on their scores) will move to the next round.

### Round 2:-

- 1. The selected participants will be asked to choose from a pool of chits numbered from slots 1-16, which would decide their slot for the battle.
- 2. Adjacent slots will enter a battle. (i.e., slot 1 vs slot 2).
- 3. A bottle spin will decide who goes first among each pair.
- 4. Judges will then choose 1 contestant out of each pair to progress to the next round after every battle.
- 5. Time limit is same as previous round.






### Round 3:-

- 1. The selected participants will be asked to choose from a pool of chits numbered from slots 1-8, which would decide their slot for the battle.
- 2. Adjacent slots will enter a battle. (slot 1 vs slot 2 etc.).
- 3. Judges will then choose 1 contestant out of each pair to progress to the next round after every battle.
- 4. Time limit is same as previous round.
- 5. Slots will be allotted as per normal.
- 6.A handicap / condition will be enforced to each of the participant. This will be done through randomized chits that contain the stipulation.


### Round 4:-
